Today, [Los Angeles County \(PDF\)](#) and the [City of Los Angeles \(PDF\)](#), among other nearby jurisdictions, ordered all residents to stay home starting 11:59 p.m., March 19, through April 19, 2020, which are actions similar to those of other large metropolitan areas attempting to limit the spread of COVID-19. Educational institutions, like Angeles College, are subject to these orders but are considered essential businesses. This means we will suspend all on-campus operations with the exception of those that are essential and cannot be conducted remotely, effective 11:59 p.m. on March 20, 2020.
