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Prelicensure BS Nursing Program Launched

In response to the ongoing demand for a new BSN program in Los Angeles to accommodate its high school graduates and other nursing school applicants currently waitlisted to start their Nursing education, Angeles College, is proud to launch its newly approved prelicensure Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program. This will be an accelerated 3-year program comprised of 12 continuous quarters. New applications are now accepted for the Spring Quarter which starts on April 26, 2021.

The BSN program will provide a learning experience that will promote critical thinking, logic and clinical judgment. It will provide the opportunity for students to continuously improve nursing care through systematic investigation of nursing care outcomes and discover innovations they can use in the nursing profession. The curriculum will prepare the students with the nursing knowledge, nursing skill, as well as soft skills necessary toward excellent management of patient care.

The minimum educational requirement to enroll is a GED or diploma from an accredited HS. Transfer credits may be applied for any general education and nursing courses earned from an accredited college. LVN and military personnel who gained medical-related

experience through training may also apply for transfer credits. A separate application is filed along with an Official Transcript and reviewed by the Dean of Nursing.

Limited seats are available and applicants with the highest earned Admissions Points will be registered into the program.




Majority of her work involved improving the academic portion of the program to obtain NCLEX scores of 90% and above. As an NCLEX Specialist for the last 3-years, she has: increased the NCLEX passing rate from 75% to 100% per Quarter; increased ATI utilization from 20% to 200%; improved retention rates by preventing academic fails; improved ATI proctored exam scores for

Fundamentals, Pharmacology and Community Health; and strengthened the Nursing Curriculum through the development of a new Nurse Knowledge Exchange (NKE) and rubrics in line with the Next Generation NCLEX Exam.

She accomplished these through various roles including: Instructor, Skills Lab Coordinator, NCLEX Specialist and Associate Dean for Academics. She brings in this same passion to Angeles College. She credits her achievements in her passion in educating the future generation of Nurses.
